

## TRAIL CREW NOTES

18 November 2023

Location: Gray Wolf Trail (834), ONF

Hours on job: 9

- Objective(s) for the day:
  - Remove reported fallen tree on trail and one on Cat Creek loop
  - Scout trail to end (4.2 mile point)
- Task(s) accomplished:
  - Remove fallen (18" diameter) tree reported by Klahane Club
  - Remove fallen (14" diameter) tree from Cat Creek connector.
  - Clear small rock slide from riverside trail.
  - Minor brushing and trail clearing.
  - Scouted trail and noted areas needing rebenching.
- Task(s) remaining:
  - Several hundred feet of hillside trail are near complete failure. Hikers are sliding onto the downhill slope. Much of the hillside trail past the two mile point needs to be rebenched.
    - This will take 3-4 days of work. Recommend an overnight trip with camping at the third and second riverside campsites.
  - There are still cut logs protruding into the trail on the first river flat in the half mile inside the wilderness boundary line.
