


On our list of things to do:

- 1. Finish debarking both trees.
- 2. Create a safe platform on a steep hillside for the felling of the snag that we need to do before we start on the trees.
- 3. Dig, dig and dig under both trees especially the larger one which still had a lot of dirt and rocks under where the saw will be running.
- 4. Finish cutting off that last overhanging root.
- 5. Dig and clear out good safe stances for the sawyers.
- 6. Put more work into escape routes for the sawyers.
- 7. Have the packers check out the spot where WTA had flattened some stock hang out areas they both checked it out and approved. No more work necessary there (I will thank that crew's WTA leader, Al Mashburn).

We finished cutting off that last overhanging root that you saw in the last report (thank you, David! That was a difficult job). Of course, then it landed with a few of its tendrils jammed into the ground, above where the sawyer for the larger tree will be standing. We tried to move it but it is impaled into the ground. If we cut off the bottom of it, that will get it out of the way of the sawyer, but we still don't like having that above the sawyer. We'll take in a come-along to see if we can move it before the actual tree cut begins. Other than that, we're ready.
